



2009 ACI - ROCKY MOUNTAIN CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP

The ACI - Rocky Mountain Chapter Scholarship is a \$1000 grant offered to Engineering students who show an interest in furthering the Research and Development of Concrete as a construction medium.

Eligibility requirements:

1. Any currently enrolled freshman, sophomore, junior, or senior who will be registered as an undergraduate in their respective class, and is a member of the ACI Rocky Mountain Chapter. Membership applications can be submitted with Scholarship Application.
2. The Scholarship may be awarded only to those students who will use them to continue their official undergraduate education at an ABET accredited educational establishment.

Applications must include:

- Completed application form. Download a PDF version of the application to be filled out.
- Personal essay which shall be no less than 500 words and no more than 1000 words. The essay shall highlight why the applicant chose to become an Engineer, specific ACI Student Chapter involvement, interests in concrete, long term goals, and special financial needs.
- One letter of recommendation from any faculty member or Concrete Professional
- One sealed official transcript for any University attended in the last 4 years
- One-page resume.
